

§ 108A-118.1. Definitions.

The following definitions apply in this Article:

- (1) Case Review Multidisciplinary Team. – An adult protection multidisciplinary team that reviews selected active cases in which disabled adults and older adults are being served by adult protective services through a local department of social services.
- (2) Director of social services. – As defined by G.S. 108A-74.
- (3) Disabled adult. – An individual 18 years of age or older or a lawfully emancipated minor who is present in the State of North Carolina and who is physically or mentally incapacitated, as defined in G.S. 108A-101(d).
- (4) Older adult. – An individual 65 years of age or older.
- (5) Systemic Review Multidisciplinary Team. – An adult protection multidisciplinary team that works together to do all of the following:
 - a. Address systemic problems and service gaps that may exist in the delivery of services to disabled adults or older adults by public and nonpublic agencies.
 - b. Develop information networks.
 - c. Provide coordinated community education and outreach designed to protect against abuse, neglect, and exploitation of disabled adults or older adults. (2025-23, s. 1.)
