A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Aging, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be divided equally among the four chapters of the Alzheimer's Association of North Carolina as follows: the Western Alzheimer's Chapter, the Southern Piedmont Alzheimer's Chapter, the Eastern Alzheimer's Chapter, and the Triad Alzheimer's Chapter.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
