A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A STUDY OF THE
NONINSTRUCTIONAL DUTIES OF TEACHERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Assembly the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall use these funds to study issues relating to the noninstructional duties of teachers. The study should include, but not be limited to, noninstructional duties during the workday; noninstructional duties outside of the workday; pay for noninstructional duties; and the relationship between athletic duties and other duties such as club advisors and equitable pays.

The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall report the results of this study to the General Assembly prior to the beginning of the Regular 1998 Session of the General Assembly.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
