**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CITY OF MAXTON FOR THE  
REHABILITATION OF THE RECREATION CENTER AND GYM BUILT IN THE  
EARLY 1940'S BY THE DAVIS BROTHERS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Maxton in Robeson County the sum of one hundred twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$128,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to assist in the costs of rehabilitating the recreation center and gym built by the Davis Brothers in the early 1940's. This recreation center has a rich history, and once restored, can continue to have a positive impact on the youth of Maxton and the surrounding area.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
