A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT INMATE ROAD SQUADS IN DAVIDSON COUNTY
SHALL WEAR UNIFORMS IDENTIFYING THEM AS INMATES.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Correction and the Department of Transportation shall require all inmate road squads, maintenance road squads, and community work crews working in Davidson County to wear horizontally striped uniforms with stripes of three inches in width and color-coded by inmate classification in a manner consistent with the color-coding used by Davidson County for its road squads.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to provide uniforms required by this act.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
