1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE
3 SERVICES COMMISSION TO ALL OF SALISBURY STREET PROXIMATE TO
4 THE STATE LEGISLATIVE BUILDING.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 120-32.1(d) reads as rewritten:

7 "(d) For the purposes of this section, the term "State legislative buildings and
8 grounds" means:

9 (1) At all times:

10 a. The State Legislative Building;

11 a1. The areas between the outer walls of the State Legislative
12 Building and the near curblineline of those sections of ~~Jones,~~
13 ~~Wilmington, and Salisbury~~ Jones and Wilmington Streets which
14 border land on which it is situated;

15 a2. The area between the outer walls of the State Legislative
16 Building and the far curblineline of ~~that section of Lane Street~~ which
17 ~~borders~~ those sections of Lane and Salisbury Streets which
18 border the land on which it is situated;

- 1 b. The Legislative Office Building and the areas between its outer
2 walls and the near curblineline of those sections of Lane and
3 Salisbury Streets that border the land on which it is situated;
4 c. Any State-owned parking lot which is leased to the General
5 Assembly; and
6 d. The bridge between the State Legislative Building and the State
7 Governmental Mall.
- 8 (2) In addition, the surface area to the far curblineline of those sections of ~~Jones,~~
9 ~~Wilmington, and Salisbury~~ Jones and Wilmington Streets which border
10 the land on which the State Legislative Building is situated:
11 a. When the General Assembly is in regular or extra session; and
12 b. On other days on which one or more standing committees of
13 either or both houses of the General Assembly are meeting and
14 the Legislative Services Officer determines that additional
15 parking is needed for the functioning of the General Assembly
16 and files notice of the committee's or committees' meetings and
17 his finding that additional parking is needed in the office of the
18 Secretary of State and that of Clerk of the Superior Court of
19 Wake County."
20 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
