1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 ANACT TO **PROVIDE** THAT SPECIAL **PURPLE** HEART **AWARD** 3 REGISTRATION PLATES SHALL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN ADDITIONAL 4 FEE, AND TO PROVIDE THAT SURVIVING SPOUSES OF PURPLE HEART 5 PLATE HOLDERS MAY CONTINUE TO BE ISSUED THOSE PLATES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b)(22) reads as rewritten: 8 "(22) Purple Heart Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the Purple Heart award. Also issuable to the surviving spouse of a person who 9 10 had a Purple Heart plate at the time of death so long as the surviving spouse continues to renew the plate and does not remarry. The plate 11 shall bear the phrase 'Purple Heart Veteran, Combat Wounded' and 12 the letters 'PH'." 13

Section 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:
