A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF KINGS MOUNTAIN TO EXTEND ITS

EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION TWO MILES FROM ITS CITY LIMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 160A-360(a), the City of Kings Mountain may exercise the powers granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statues within a defined area, within Cleveland County, extending not more than two miles beyond the City of Kings Mountain corporate limits, provided that the City may not extend its extraterritorial powers under this act into any area for which the County at that time has adopted and is enforcing a zoning ordinance and subdivision regulations and within which the County is enforcing the State Building Code. However, the City may do so where the County gives permission, or when the City and the County have agreed upon the area within which each will exercise the powers conferred by Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
