2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT INFORMATION IN THE STOKES COUNTY 911
3 DATABASE OBTAINED FROM A TELEPHONE COMPANY IS
4 CONFIDENTIAL IF REQUIRED BY THE AGREEMENT OBTAINING THE
5 INFORMATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Automatic number identification and automatic location
8 identification information that consists of the name, address, and telephone numbers of
9 telephone subscribers which is contained in a county 911 database is confidential and is
10 not a public record if that information is required to be confidential by the agreement
11 with the telephone company by which the information was obtained. Dissemination of
12 the information contained in the 911 automatic number and automatic location database
13 is prohibited except on a call-by-call basis only for the purpose of handling emergency
14 calls, or for training and any permanent record of the information shall be secured by the
15 public safety answering points and disposed of in a manner which will retain that security
16 except as otherwise required by applicable law.

17 Section 2. This act applies to Stokes County only.

18 Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
