A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE WILLIAM STATES LEE
LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE AND TO RENOVATE AND SUPPORT THE
HISTORIC WHITE OAKS MANSION.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Lynnwood Foundation, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for operating expenses of the William States Lee Leadership Institute, which is held at the historic White Oaks mansion, and for renovating and operating expenses of the White Oaks mansion.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
