The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 160A-20(h) reads as rewritten: As used in this section, the term "unit of local government" means any of the "(h) following: A county. (1) A city. (2) (3) A water and sewer authority created under Article 1 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes.-Statutes or a metropolitan sewerage district created under Article 5 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes. **(4)** An airport authority whose situs is entirely within a county that has (i) a population of over 120,000 according to the most recent federal decennial census and (ii) an area of less than 200 square miles. An airport authority in a county in which there are two incorporated (5) municipalities with a population of more than 65,000 according to the

most recent federal decennial census
