A sanitary district created under Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 130A of 1 (3b)2 the General Statutes. 3 (4) An airport authority whose situs is entirely within a county that has (i) a 4 population of over 120,000 according to the most recent federal 5 decennial census and (ii) an area of less than 200 square miles. 6 (5) An airport authority in a county in which there are two incorporated 7 municipalities with a population of more than 65,000 according to the 8 most recent federal decennial census. 9 (5a) An airport board or commission authorized by agreement between two 10 cities pursuant to G.S. 63-56, one of which is located partially but not wholly in the county in which the jointly owned airport is located, and 11 12 where the board or commission provided water and wastewater services off the airport premises before January 1, 1995; provided that the 13 14 authority granted by this section may be exercised by such a board or 15 commission with respect to water and wastewater systems or 16 improvements only. A local school administrative unit (i) that is located in a county that has 17 (6) 18 a population of over 90,000 according to the most recent federal 19 decennial census and (ii) whose board of education is authorized to levy 20 a school tax. 21 **(7)** An area mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse authority, acting in accordance with G.S. 122C-147. 22 23 A consolidated city-county, as defined by G.S. 160B-2(1)." (8)
