SENATE BILL 587

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO GIVE CLASSROOM EXPERIENCE TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO
ARE CERTIFIED TEACHERS BUT ARE NOT CLASSROOM TEACHERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(18A) To Make Rules Requiring Certain Employees to Serve as Substitute Teachers. – In order to improve employees' awareness of classroom climate and to enhance school discipline, local boards of education shall require each employee who holds a teaching certificate but who is not assigned to a classroom to serve as a substitute in the classroom at least two days each school year."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 1997-98 school year.
