The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
Section 1. Chapter 102 of the 1957 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 589 of the 1963 Session Laws and Chapter 606 of the 1967 Session Laws, is repealed. Section 2. All funds held by the Trustees of the Albemarle Supplementary	
Pension Fund are transferred to the Board of Trustees of the Albemarle Firemen's Relief Fund to be held and administered as provided in Article 84 of Chapter 58 of the General	
Statutes. Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
