A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAMS OF THE AFRICAN-AMERICAN STORYTELLERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to assist the African-American Storytellers in providing programs to school-age children throughout the State that encourage reading and promote cultural diversity.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
