A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AT THE
CHARLOTTE HAWKINS BROWN STATE HISTORIC SITE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Charlotte Hawkins Brown Historical Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for the construction of shelters and rest room facilities to enhance the ability to conduct activities and accommodate visitors at the Charlotte Hawkins Brown State Historical Site.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Charlotte Hawkins Brown Historical Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of eight hundred forty-two thousand dollars (\$842,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to renovate Kimball Hall in order to provide adequate meeting space and exhibition space, and other compatible uses.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
