A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE
2 RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE.

3 Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain appointments to
public offices upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and
Whereas, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate has made recommendations; Now,
therefore,

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 143B-350(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) The Board of Transportation shall have ~~two~~four members appointed by the
7 General Assembly. ~~One~~Two of these members shall be appointed upon the
8 recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and ~~one~~two shall be
9 appointed upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in
10 accordance with G.S. 120-121. The initial members appointed by the General Assembly
11 shall serve for terms expiring June 30, 1983. The additional two members appointed by
12 the General Assembly shall serve for terms expiring June 30, 1999. Thereafter, their
13 successors shall serve for two-year terms beginning July 1 of odd-numbered years.
14 Vacancies in appointments made by the General Assembly shall be filled in accordance
15 with G.S. 120-122."

- 1 Section 2. Unless otherwise specified, all appointments made by this act are
2 for terms to begin July 1, 1997.
3 Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. ♦
