A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE
2 KOREAN WAR VETERAN SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

5 “(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
6 plates:

9 (20b) Korean War Veteran. – Issuable to a veteran of the armed forces of the
10 United States who served during the Korean Conflict, which began
11 June 27, 1950, and ended January 31, 1955. The plate shall bear the
12 words “Korean War Veteran” and a representation of the Republic of
13 Korea Service Medal. The Division may not issue the plate authorized
14 by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the
15 plate.”

16 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
