A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE
3 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES TO VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II, THE
4 KOREAN WAR, AND THE UNITED STATES NAVY SUBMARINE SERVICE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

7 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
8 plates:

9 ...

10 (20b) Korean War Veteran. – Issuable to a veteran of the armed forces of the
11 United States who served during the Korean Conflict, which began
12 June 27, 1950, and ended January 31, 1955. The plate shall bear the
13 words "Korean War Veteran" and a representation of the Republic of
14 Korea Service Medal. The Division may not issue the plate authorized
15 by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the
16 plate."

17 ...

18 (46a) U.S. Navy Specialty. – Issuable to a veteran of the United States Navy
19 Submariner Service. The plate shall bear the phrase "Silent Service
20 Veteran" and shall bear a representation of the Submarine Service
21 Qualification pin. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by
22 this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the
23 plate."

24 ...

25 (52) World War II. – Issuable to a veteran of the armed forces of the United
26 States who served during World War II, which began December 7,
27 1941, and ended December 31, 1946, or to the veteran's spouse. The
28 plate shall bear the words "World War II Veteran" and shall bear a
29 representation of the National Iwo Jima Monument. The Division may

1 not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at
2 least 300 applications for the plate."

3 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
