(2) The need for the authority to exercise extraterritorial ju	urisdiction by
municipalities with a population under 500.	
(3) Other issues related to extraterritorial jurisdiction.	
The Commission may report to the 2002 Regular Session of the	2001 General
Assembly or to the 2003 General Assembly on its findings and ma	ay make any
legislative recommendations it considers appropriate.
