A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A
CHILDREN'S MUSEUM IN WINSTON-SALEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Children's Museum of Winston-Salem, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year for the construction of a children's museum to provide interactive, exciting exhibits and programming that will appeal to young children, offer opportunities for social, physical, intellectual, and sensory stimulation, and feature resources for effective parenting and quality early childhood education.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
