A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW CREATION OF THE UPPER CAPE FEAR WATER
AUTHORITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 162A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
new section to read:

"§ 162A-3.3. Water authority in urban county.

(a) Two or more units of local government, at least one of which is located
primarily in a county with a population of 500,000 or over, according to the most recent
decennial federal census, and whose wastewater discharge flows downstream solely
within this State, may organize a water and sewer authority only under this section.
Except as modified by this section, the remainder of this Article applies to such
authority.

(b) Any authority organized under this section shall be governed by a board
consisting of one member appointed by the governing board of each of the participating
political subdivisions. Each member so appointed shall have one vote.

(c) An authority organized under this section may issue revenue bonds under
G.S. 162A-6(6) and may collect rates, fees, and other charges as provided by G.S.
162A-6(9)."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
