HOUSE BILL 1487**

AN ACT TO EXTEND EXPIRATION OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT JUST  
COMPENSATION BE PAID FOR THE REMOVAL BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES  
OF BILLBOARDS ON INTERSTATE AND FEDERAL-AID PRIMARY  
HIGHWAYS, AS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of Chapter 1147 of the 1981 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 318 of the 1983 Session Laws, Chapter 1024 of the 1987 Session Laws, Section 1 of Chapter 166 of the 1989 Session Laws, Section 1 of Chapter 725 of the 1993 Session Laws, Section 7 of S.L. 1998-23, and Section 27.5 of S.L. 1998-212, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification, but shall expire ~~June 30, 2002~~, upon amendment to or repeal of 23 U.S.C. § 131(g), and shall have no force or effect after that date."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2002.
