A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT AUTHORIZING A STUDY ON TEACHER RECRUITMENT AND
2 RETENTION.
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4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall
6 study teacher recruitment and retention. In the course of the study, the Committee shall
7 consider:

- 8 (1) Strategies for expanding the pool of qualified teachers,
9 (2) The use of recruitment and retention incentives to attract and retain
10 high-quality teachers, especially in low-performing schools and in
11 fields of certification in which there are shortages of teachers, and
12 (3) Other strategies for addressing the problem.

13 **SECTION 2.** The Committee shall report the results of this study to the
14 2003 General Assembly.

15 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General
16 Assembly the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to
17 implement the provisions of this act.

18 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
