1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF GREENSBORO TO COLLECT A TAX
3 ON MOTOR VEHICLES RESIDENT IN THE CITY.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:
6 "(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not
7 more than ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ thirty dollars (\$30.00) per year upon any vehicle resident
8 in the city or town. The proceeds of the tax may be used for any lawful purpose."
9 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 31 of the 1991 Session Laws is repealed.
10 **SECTION 3.** This act applies to the City of Greensboro only.
11 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
