A HOUSE RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT NO LOBBYIST BE ALLOWED TO LOBBY THE NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEMBERS IF THAT LOBBYIST RECEIVES MEMBERSHIP FEES OR FUNDS THAT ARE OBTAINED FROM ANY GOVERNMENT SOURCE THAT TAXPAYERS FUND OR FROM REVENUE THAT IS PAID IN BY THE TAXPAYERS OF NORTH CAROLINA.

SECTION 1. The House of Representatives prohibits lobbyists from lobbying the members of the North Carolina General Assembly if that lobbyist receives membership fees or funds that are obtained from any government source that taxpayers fund or from revenue that is paid in by the taxpayers of North Carolina.

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
