A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THREE ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGES
IN DISTRICT 10.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

42 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judges
 43 for District Court District 10 authorized by Section 1 of this act. Those judges'

1 successors shall be elected in the 2004 election for four-year terms commencing on the
2 first Monday in December 2004.

3 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
4 Department the sum of four hundred eleven thousand nine hundred thirty-three dollars
5 (\$411,933) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred seventy thousand
6 five hundred twelve dollars (\$370,512) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to establish the
7 three new district court judges provided for in this act.

8 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001.
