A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE CHARLOTTE-2 3 MECKLENBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM FOUR YEARS TO TWO 4 YEARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2(a) of Chapter 167 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

In 1995 and quadrennially thereafter, 1999, three members of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected for four-year terms by all the qualified voters of Mecklenburg County. In 2003 and biennially thereafter, three members of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected for twoyear terms by all the qualified voters of Mecklenburg County."

SECTION 2. Section 2(c) of Chapter 167 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

In 1995, one member of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected from each district for a two-year term by all the qualified voters of the district. In 1997 and quadrennially thereafter, 1997 one member of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected from each district for a four-year term by all the qualified voters of the district. In 2001 and biennially thereafter, one member of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected from each district for a two-year term by all the qualified voters of the district."

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
