2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENABLE THE TEACCH PROGRAM TO
3 PROVIDE SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND ADULTS WITH AUTISM AND
4 OTHER COMMUNICATION HANDICAPS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
7 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred ninety thousand
8 dollars (\$290,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated for
9 Division TEACCH at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill as follows:

- 10 (1) \$75,000 for a clinical director at the Raleigh TEACCH Center;
11 (2) \$10,500 for consultation to the Murdoch Center for staff training;
12 (3) \$90,000 for the UNC Psychiatric Clinic;
13 (4) \$115,000 for support staff for the Neuro-Developmental Research
14 Center Autism Research Budget.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
