2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO CONDUCT AN
3 ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON CAPITAL INVESTMENTS IN SPORTS AND
4 CULTURAL FACILITIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Charlotte City Council may, by resolution, direct the
7 Mecklenburg County Board of Elections to conduct an advisory referendum on whether
8 the City should make capital investments in certain identified sports and cultural
9 facilities. The resolution shall prescribe the form of the ballot question and shall set the
10 date of the referendum. The referendum shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter
11 163 of the General Statutes.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall expire on December 31, 2001.

13 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
