reducing the deer population in the Town to a manageable level. The Con	nmission shall
consider all appropriate and feasible options available to bring the deer population	oulation under
control as quickly as possible.	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> The Commission shall report to the General A	ssembly upon
the convening of the 2002 Regular Session of the 2001 General Ass	sembly on its
progress in reducing the deer population in the Town of Biltmore Forest.	
<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
