A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW WITH REGARD TO RESISTING,
OBSTRUCTING, OR DELAYING A PUBLIC OFFICER IN DISCHARGING
OFFICIAL DUTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-223 reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-223. ~~Resisting officers.~~ **officers; delay or obstruct officer in discharge of official duty.**

(a) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully ~~resist, delay or obstruct~~ physically resist a public officer in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his or her office, ~~he~~ the person shall be guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.

(b) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully delay or obstruct a public officer in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his or her office, the person shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
