



1           shall be seated beside the license holder in the front seat of the vehicle  
2           when it is in motion. The supervising driver need not be the only other  
3           occupant of the front seat, but ~~must~~shall be the person seated next to  
4           the license holder.

5           (4) When the license holder is driving the vehicle and is not accompanied  
6           by the supervising driver, there may be no more than one passenger  
7           under 21 years of age in the vehicle. This limit does not apply to  
8           passengers who are members of the license holder's immediate family  
9           or whose primary residence is the same household as the license  
10           holder. However, if a family member or member of the same  
11           household as the license holder who is younger than 21 years of age is  
12           a passenger in the vehicle, no other passengers under 21 years of age,  
13           who are not members of the license holder's immediate family or  
14           members of the same household, may be in the vehicle.

15           (4)(5) Every person occupying the vehicle being driven by the license holder  
16           must have a safety belt properly fastened about his or her body, or be  
17           restrained by a child passenger restraint system as provided in G.S.  
18           20-137.1(a), when the vehicle is in motion."

19           **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2002, and applies to  
20           limited provisional licenses issued on or after that date.
