2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES TO
3 ERECT A SECOND HISTORICAL MARKER COMMEMORATING AN
4 INDIVIDUAL.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 121-4(7), any rule, or other provision of
7 law, the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, shall
8 have the Department of Transportation erect a second historical marker commemorating
9 an individual who has been honored previously with a marker provided that the marker
10 is in a location different than the first marker and the information on the second marker
11 is accurate. Notwithstanding G.S. 136-42.3, all costs associated with erecting a second
12 marker shall be borne by private entities.

13 **SECTION 2.** This acts applies to the Town of Lillington only.

14 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
