2 AN ACT TO CONVERT THREE TEMPORARY AVIATION POSITIONS WITHIN
3 THE DIVISION OF FOREST RESOURCES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
4 ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PERMANENT
5 POSITIONS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THIS
6 CONVERSION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** The two temporary pilot positions within the Division of
9 Forest Resources of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources are
10 converted to permanent positions.

11 **SECTION 2.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
12 Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the
13 sum of thirty-seven thousand four hundred seventy-four dollars (\$37,474) for the
14 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-seven thousand four hundred seventy-four
15 dollars (\$37,474) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to establish and support the permanent
16 positions under Section 1 of this act.

17 **SECTION 2.(b)** The sum needed to establish and support the pilot positions
18 as permanent positions equals eighty-nine thousand four hundred seventy-four dollars
19 (\$89,474) for each the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the 2002-2003 fiscal year. The sum
20 needed to continue and support the pilot positions as temporary positions equals
21 fifty-two thousand dollars (\$52,000) for each the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the
22 2002-2003 fiscal year. The funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this section
23 represent the difference between these two sums.

24 **SECTION 3.** The temporary position of aircraft mechanic within the
25 Division of Forest Resources of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources
26 is converted to a permanent position.

27 **SECTION 4.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
28 Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the

1 sum of twenty-one thousand three hundred ninety-three dollars (\$21,393) for the
2 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-one thousand three hundred ninety-three
3 dollars (\$21,393) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to establish and support the permanent
4 position under Section 3 of this act.

5 **SECTION 4.(b)** The sum needed to establish and support the position of
6 aircraft mechanic as a permanent position equals forty-five thousand one hundred five
7 dollars (\$45,105) for each the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the 2002-2003 fiscal year. The
8 sum needed to continue and support the position of aircraft mechanic as a temporary
9 position equals twenty-three thousand seven hundred twelve dollars (\$23,712) for each
10 the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the 2002-2003 fiscal year. The funds appropriated under
11 subsection (a) of this section represent the difference between these two sums.

12 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
