

1 (b) Rules that establish a minimum distance from a building foundation for a
2 water supply well shall provide that an institution or facility located in a single-family
3 dwelling served by a water supply well that is located closer to a building foundation
4 than the minimum distance specified in the rules may be licensed or approved if the
5 results of water testing meet or exceed standards established by the Commission and
6 there are no other potential health hazards associated with the well. At the time of
7 application for licensure or approval, water shall be sampled and tested for pesticides,
8 nitrates, and bacteria. Thereafter, water shall be sampled and tested at intervals
9 determined by the Commission but not less than annually. A registered sanitarian or
10 other health official who is qualified by training and experience shall collect the water
11 samples as required by this subsection and may examine the well location to determine
12 if there are other potential health hazards associated with the well. A well shall comply
13 with all other applicable sanitation requirements established by the Commission.

14 (b1) Rules pertaining to the approval of springs that supply water to an institution
15 or facility located in a single-family dwelling shall provide that the institution or facility
16 may be licensed or approved if the results of testing of the springwater meet or exceed
17 standards applicable for a water supply well. At the time of application for licensure or
18 approval, the springwater shall be sampled and tested for pesticides, nitrates, and
19 bacteria. Thereafter, water shall be sampled and tested at intervals determined by the
20 Commission but not less frequently than annually. A registered sanitarian or other
21 health official who is qualified by training and experience shall collect the water
22 samples as required by this subsection and may examine the spring location to
23 determine if there are other potential health hazards associated with the spring.

24 (c) The Department may suspend or revoke a license or approval for a violation
25 of this section or rules adopted by the Commission."

26 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
