A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DIABETES PREVENTION AND
2 CONTROL.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two hundred fifty thousand
7 dollars (\$250,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty
8 thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year for diabetes prevention and
9 control. These funds may be used for community-based diabetes awareness and
10 education programs, coalition-building, outreach for early detection and intervention,
11 enhanced provider training in the prevention and self-management of diabetes and its
12 health consequences, and a strengthened focus on minority populations experiencing
13 disparities in the burden of diabetes.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
