The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 20-51 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
"§ 20-51. Exempt from registration.		
The following shall be exempt from the requirement of registration and certificate of		
title:		
(14) Any	vehicle that meets all of the following:	
<u>a.</u>	Is designed for use in work off the highway.	
<u>b.</u>	Is used for agricultural quarantine programs	under the
	supervision of the Department of Agriculture and	Consumer
	Services.	
<u>c.</u>	Is driven or moved on the highway for the purpose	of going to
	and from nonhighway projects.	
<u>d.</u>	Is identified in a manner approved by the Division	<u>n of Motor</u>
	Vehicles.	
<u>e.</u>	Is operated by a person who possesses an identifi	cation card
	issued by the Department of Agriculture and	Consumer
Services."		
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
