A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA FARMLAND PRESERVATION TRUST FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Farmland Preservation Trust Fund in the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to be used for the purchase of agricultural conservation easements under Article 61 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
