A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AN ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON AN EDUCATION
LOTTERY FOR NORTH CAROLINA ON NOVEMBER 5, 2002.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The question of whether the voters of North Carolina want an
Education Lottery shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the State at an election on
November 5, 2002.

The election shall be conducted under the laws then governing elections in
the State. Ballots, voting systems, or both may be used in accordance with Chapter 163
of the General Statutes. The question to be used in the voting systems and ballots shall
be:

"[] YES [] NO

North Carolina should have an Education Lottery."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
