33 **SECTION 3.** At the request of the Board of Governors of The University of
34 North Carolina and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so,
35 the Director of the Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the cost of, or a
36 change in the method of funding the projects authorized by this act. In determining
37 whether to authorize a change in cost or funding, the Director of the Budget may consult
38 with the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations.

39 **SECTION 4.** Pursuant to G.S. 116D-26, the Board of Governors may issue,
40 subject to the approval of the Director of the Budget, at one time or from time to time,
41 special obligation bonds of the Board of Governors for the purpose of paying all or any
42 part of the cost of acquiring, constructing, or providing for the projects authorized by
43 this act.

1 **SECTION 5.** With respect to two capital projects at North Carolina State
2 University, the Alumni Center, and the Carter Finley Stadium improvements, the
3 institution may accomplish construction and financing through lease arrangements to
4 and from nonprofit corporations, as follows:

- 5 (1) Alumni Center through lease with The North Carolina State University
6 Alumni Association, Inc.
7 (2) Carter Finley Stadium improvements through lease with The North
8 Carolina State University Student Aid Association, Inc.

9 **SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
