A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE COMMERCIAL LEAKING PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND AND THE NONCOMMERCIAL LEAKING PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND TO SUPPORT THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the Commercial Leaking Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of two hundred forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$247,500) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to implement the provisions of Parts 2A and 2B of Article 21A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the Noncommercial Leaking Petroleum Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of two hundred forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$247,500) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to implement the provisions of Parts 2A and 2B of Article 21A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective 1 July 2001.
