**BILL SUMMARY:** This bill establishes new fees and increases current fees for the North Carolina Board of Electrolysis Examiners.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** The North Carolina Board of Electrolysis Examiners is requesting a change in their fee structure to raise the revenue needed to pay for expenditures. As shown in the chart below, expenditures have exceeded revenues for the past three fiscal years. The Board's cash balance has dropped from \$43,473 in 1997 to \$32,866 in 2000. At the current spending rate, this cash balance will be depleted within five years.

The proposed fees are maximum amounts that the Board can charge. As shown in the chart below, if the Board charged the maximum allowable fees then revenue would increase from \$13,690 to \$41,550.

The increased revenue in FY 2001-02 will allow the Board to compensate Board members for travel and per diem, will increase contracted inspections, and will pay for legal and audit fees. While the fees will increase over the next five years, the Board expects little change in the number of licensees. This fiscal note assumes no growth in licenses.
