A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF LARCENY OF A MOTOR  
VEHICLE PART.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Article 16 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by  
adding a new section to read:

**"§ 14-72.8. Felony larceny of motor vehicle parts.**

Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater  
punishment, larceny of a motor vehicle part is a Class I felony if the cost of repairing the motor  
vehicle is one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more.

For purposes of this section, the cost of repairing a motor vehicle means the cost of any  
replacement part and any additional costs necessary to install the replacement part in the motor  
vehicle."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to  
offenses committed on or after that date.
