1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE HEALTH PLAN BLUE RIBBON TASK FORCE.  
3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 7.(b) of S.L. 2009-16 reads as rewritten:

5 **"SECTION 7.(b)** The Task Force shall consist of 15 members, appointed as follows:

- 6 (1) Six members by the ~~General Assembly upon the recommendation of~~  
7 ~~the~~Speaker of the House of Representatives, three of whom shall be  
8 members of the House of Representatives, one shall be a public  
9 schoolteacher, one shall be a State or covered local government retiree other  
10 than a retired public schoolteacher, and one at-large. Of the three legislators  
11 appointed to the Task Force, one shall be a member of the minority party.  
12 (2) Six members by the ~~General Assembly upon the recommendation of~~  
13 ~~the~~President Pro Tempore of the Senate, three of whom shall be members of  
14 the Senate, one shall be a State employee who is not a public schoolteacher,  
15 one shall be a retired State public school employee, and one at-large. Of the  
16 three legislators appointed to the Task Force, one shall be a member of the  
17 minority party.  
18 (3) One member by the Governor with expertise in the business of health  
19 insurance or in administering health care services other than an insurance  
20 company or third-party administrator or contractor of the Plan.  
21 (4) The chair of the Board of Trustees of the State Health Plan or the chair's  
22 designee.  
23 (5) The Commissioner of Insurance or the Commissioner's designee."

24 **SECTION 2.** Effective December 31, 2010, Part 7 of S.L. 2009-16, as amended by  
25 Section 1 of this act, is repealed.

26 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
