1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REVISE THE CRITERIA FOR SECURE CUSTODY OF DELINQUENT
3 JUVENILES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7B-1903(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) The court may order secure custody for a juvenile who is alleged to have violated
7 the conditions of the juvenile's probation or post-release supervision, ~~but only if~~ supervision if
8 the court finds any of the following:

9 (1) ~~the~~ The juvenile is alleged to have committed acts that damage property or
10 injure persons.

11 (2) The juvenile is alleged to have committed acts that pose a danger to the
12 juvenile or others.

13 (3) The juvenile has absconded from the juvenile's current placement and is
14 unavailable to be supervised safely."

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to
16 offenses committed on or after that date.
