A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE PERSONAL LEAVE FOR TEACHER ASSISTANTS WHO ARE  
REQUIRED BY LAW TO HAVE A SUBSTITUTE WHEN THEY ARE OUT OF THE  
CLASSROOM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-316 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(e) Teacher assistants who are required by law to have a substitute when they are out of the classroom shall earn and use personal leave under the same terms and conditions as classroom teachers for as long as they are in a position that requires them to have a substitute."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
