A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY
THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COYOTE NUISANCE REMOVAL PROGRAM IN THIS
STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the development of a coyote nuisance removal program aimed at diminishing the threat presented by the existence of a coyote population in this State. The Commission shall consider all appropriate and feasible options available for effectively reducing the coyote population in this State as quickly as possible.

SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to the 2009 General Assembly, Regular Session 2010, and shall make its final report to the 2011 General Assembly.

SECTION 3. The Legislative Services Officer shall allocate funds appropriated to the General Assembly for the expenditures of the Legislative Research Commission in conducting this study.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
