A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE'S WATER INFRASTRUCTURE
FUND TO BE USED TO MATCH THE FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR WATER
SUPPLY AND WASTEWATER NEEDS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON WATER AND WASTEWATER
INFRASTRUCTURE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Water
Infrastructure Fund established in G.S. 159G-22 the sum of thirteen million five hundred
seventy-seven thousand six hundred seventy-three dollars (\$13,577,673) for the 2010-2011
fiscal year to be used to match the federal funds available for drinking water and water supply
needs and for wastewater needs. The funds appropriated by this act shall be allocated as
follows:

- (1) \$6,223,073 shall be allocated to the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund to
be used to match federal funds available for water supply and drinking water
needs; and
- (2) \$7,354,600 shall be allocated to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund to
match federal funds available for wastewater needs.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
