February 23, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND ITS CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS SHALL NOT COUNT OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS AS IN-STATE STUDENTS FOR ANY CALCULATION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM'S STUDENT POPULATION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Part 5 of Article 3 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 116-43.16. Calculation of in-State and out-of-state students. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, The University of North Carolina and its constituent institutions shall not count any out-of-state student as an in-State student for any

calculation regarding the student population of The University System."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the 2009-2010 academic year and each subsequent academic year.
